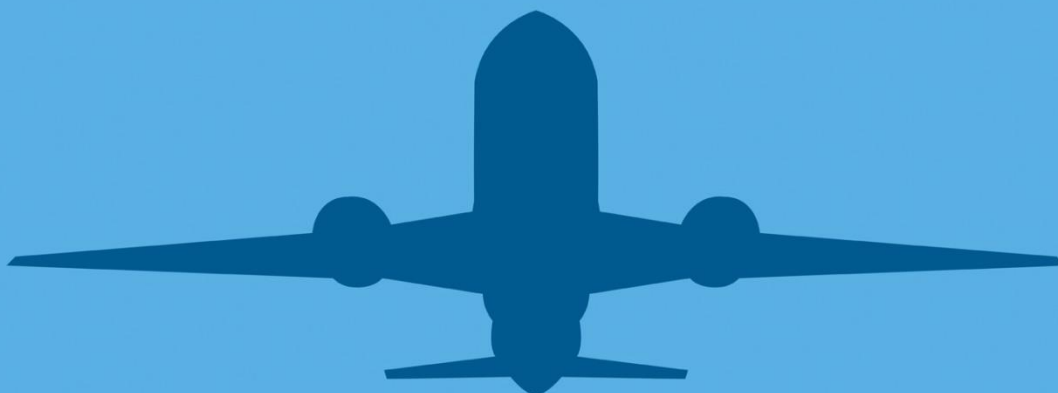

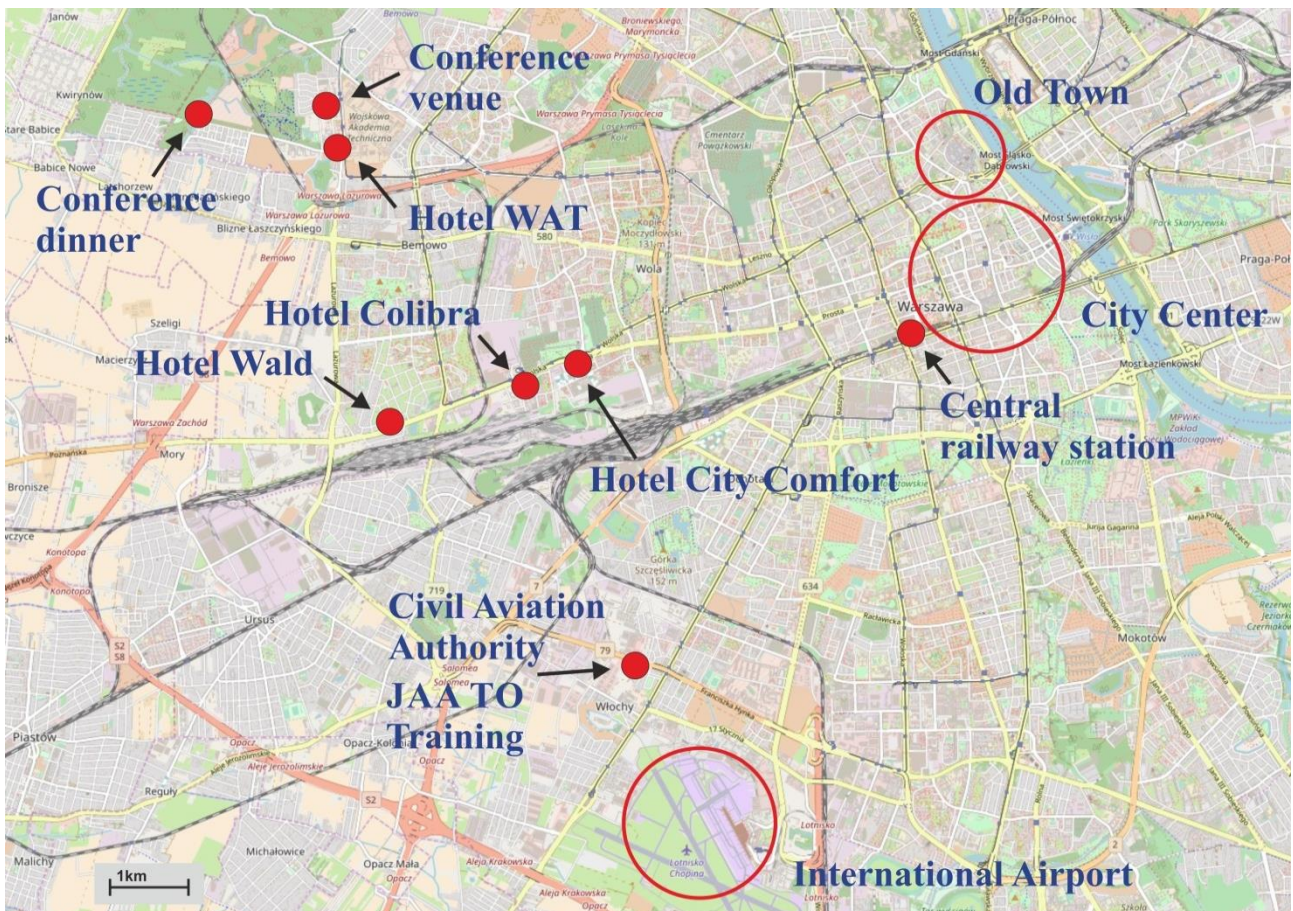

Conference map

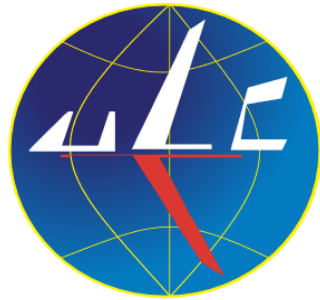
